

THE GREAT RC OCEAN RACE

2023 NOTICE OF RACE

DATE - SATURDAY April 29, 2023

LOCATION - The Dinghy Dock Floating Pub, Nanaimo Harbour, Nanaimo, B.C

THE START - is between a flag on the dinghy dock and an anchored start mark. Start time is 12:30 pm.

THE COURSE - from the start line at the Dinghy Dock Pub, to sail around Protection Island keeping Protection Island either to starboard or to port; the direction is to be determined at the skipper's meeting.

THE FINISH - is the same as the start line

TIME LIMIT: 1500 hrs, unless one boat in a division finishes, in which case the time limit for that division will be extended to 1530 hrs.

RULES - The Great RC Ocean Race shall be governed by the Racing Rules Of Sailing 2021-2024, incorporating Appendix E - Radio Sailing Racing Rules, the RC Laser Class Rules (RC Laser Class), class rules for any class with 5 boats registered forming their own division, the Sailing Instructions, any changes mandated by the principal race officer (PRO) and announced at the skippers meeting, and the chase boat rules.

ELIGIBILITY - The Great RC Ocean Race is open to all classes of radio controlled sailboats who pay the entry fee of \$25 CAD payable at the pub on the day of the race. A chase boat and driver are also required - BYOCB if possible as chase boats are limited this year. A few volunteer chase boat/drivers may be available on request. (limited availability.) 5 boats registered gets your own division (iom/soling/vics ?)

Subsequent starts will be at 5 minute intervals for any additional classes.

AWARDS - The awards ceremony will take place approximately one hour after the last boat finishes . awards will be given to the skipper and the chase boat driver. The awards are: Predicted Time Award / First To Finish (The Mini Barn Door) / Top Three In The RC Laser Class / Top Three In Division I (Open Class) .

THE MINI-BARN DOOR TROPHY - Will be awarded to the first boat to finish. Note that a new mini-barn door trophy was unveiled in 2019 after the mysterious disappearance of the last one. Thanks to Ken Holland for constructing the new trophy!

THE GRAHAM MILLINGTON MUG - Will be awarded to the RC Laser with the fastest elapsed time. Graham Millington was an RC Laser sailor, a member of the PIST Sailing Team, and a well loved resident of Protection Island. There was rarely a sailboat race that Graham missed, and with this perpetual trophy, he is always at the finish line, and in our hearts.....
